CLUMBER SPANIEL

P (1,0)

1. Lovell's Abbyford Lady Merry Of Ivale – 6 mth bitch with orange markings. Feminine pup with good bone. Pleasing outline and topline. Really enjoying her day and exuberant on the move. BPIB & RBOB

O (2,1)

1. Page's Micklemess Fundamental – 5yo male with a large square head. Sloping shoulders, well muscled body, ribs were well-sprung, powerful hindquarters and very sound on the move. BOB

COCKER SPANIEL

P (6,1)

1. Hutton-Barber's Esqueen Following Star at Babtonkelpie – 11 month blue roan girl. Feminine head with a square muzzle, clean neck and sloping shoulders. Compact body with good ribbing, muscular hindquarters with a good bend of stifle. Moved well once she relaxed and dropped into her topline. BPIB
2. White's Abzig Love Me Do At Merrysprings NAF – 7 month girl, a lot to like about this baby although I would just prefer slightly better layback of shoulder. She has good infill in her forechest, presents a lovely outline and is very sound on the move.
3. Anderson & Foster's Zakova Sundance Kyd At Sabaloo

SY (4,1)

1. Bevis & Norie-Miller's Popocatepetl Tomfoolery – 12 mth male, well presented dog, in super condition. I did find him rather plain in head but his other qualities won him the class. Good sloping shoulders, good turn of stifle, strong compact body, very sound on the move and holds his shape well. RBOB
2. Rofe's Villaspaniol Gold Flash – Golden dog, another in lovely condition. Plenty of forechest but not the shoulder of the class winner and this affects his front movement. Handled really well and enjoying his day

3. Knox's Fernstone Blue Charm

PG (5,1)

1. Clifford's Wyncastle's French Quarter Smash With Chamford – Blue roan male, Up to size, well constructed overall with good angulation front and rear. Would just prefer slightly less length of loin. Moved very soundly.
2. Quigley's Abzig My Eyes Adore You – Blue roan dog. Not the movement of the class winner but he is a compact dog with a good topline. Handled really well.
3. Rofe's Villaspaniol Sunny Delight

O (4,2)

1. Moutrey's Sunzo Songstar – 5yo golden bitch. For me today this bitch was the closest to what I was looking for. She is feminine, good chiselling in her head, clean neck, a lovely size overall, compact, pleasing outline and good angulation front and rear. Sound on the move but could be more enthusiastic. BOB
2. Stanton's Life Thru A Lens – Blue roan bitch, giving her owner a tough time but when she settled she moved out ok and has a pretty feminine head.

WSS

SY (3,0)

1. Ferguson's Julita Raindance At Teaselwood – Fine boned and still quite an immature young girl. Very feminine but typical head. Won the class with her sound movement and overall shape. Well laid shoulder and good angulation behind. Really enjoying her day. BOB
2. Morgan's Benoveor Endless Love – 2yo bitch, longer in body than the class winner and not the quality in the head. However, she has a good depth of chest, well sprung ribs, pleasing topline and shown in super condition.
3. Bennett's Cerysan Crusader

PG (5,0)

1. Bennett's Helgen Romeo The Lover For Flyboron – Heavy set 5yo dog, won the class on his breed type and overall shape, good bone, sloping shoulders, could be more compact. Held shape well on the move. RBOB
2. Primmer's Amanshe Lone Ranger – Younger male, Not the shoulder of the class winner but has good bone and pleasing breed type, clean neck, good ribcage, well angulated hindquarters. Moved ok.
3. Gough's Julita Rukestar

O (3,1)

1. Primmer's Amanshe Mermaid's Tears – 4yo bitch, although I would prefer more bone she has a good ribcage, good forechest and depth of brisket, pleasing hindquarters and topline and moved ok.
2. Jackson's Catjack Everpreciousone – What a happy girl, who was really enjoying her day. Enough bone, good ribbing and length of loin, pleasing topline and really showing her temperament with her wagging tail.
