Such a pity she moved a little close behind today but she was well boned with good strong feet. Good head with kind expression, Good coat and tail. Good ribcage and depth of chest. 1. Bowen's Flatcoated Retriever D. Ch Clandrift Bring me Sunshine JW KCWGC SGWC What a superb Dual Purpose dog who was also RBIS. Such an elegant picture standing and when he flows around the ring on the move. Typical kind head and expression. Well balanced with correct angulation, good length of neck, correct topline and tail set. A masculine but also active representative of his breed with good bone and neat strong feet. Finished off with an excellent black coat of correct texture and appropriate featherings. 2. Jenner's Lyjansen Madame Jeanette SGWC Yellow Labrador Lovely feminine head and expression. Well-balanced with correct angulation. Good neck, level topline and correct tail set. Strong well angulated quarters in good muscular condition. Correct double coat and good tail. Moved soundly but tended to look at her handler whilst moving which threw it sometimes but a very good dual-purpose representative of the breed. 3. BIS

I greatly enjoyed judging the club's BIS and thank the committee very much for inviting me and affording me this honour. I served on the club's committee from the 1980s and then as Chairman for twenty years until I stepped down in May 2024 so normally I have been busy

working at the show so it was nice to just be able to enjoy my judging and I had plenty of excellent dogs to choose from. I was looking for fit for function dogs that adhered very closely to their breed standards, were well balanced and moved well. I made an initial cut to ten dogs. The Clumber Spaniel, Gordon Setter, Chesapeake Bay Retriever, Welsh Springer Spaniel, Hungarian Vizsla, Irish Red and White Setter, Pointer, Flatcoated Retriever, Lagotto Romagnolo and the Cocker Spaniel. My final four were. BIS Goodwin and Smallwood's 3yo Pointer B Tyremy Glory Daze. By the applause I think the ringside were with me on my choice and certainly her even disposition meant she was not "dazed" by the sound. Liver and white beautifully symmetrical and well- built all over. Well proportioned and typical head. Kind expression, good nostrils and pigmentation. Super neckline and topline. Good tail set and shape thicker at the root and tapering to a point. Right amount of heart room with correct depth of chest and brisket. Super fit muscular condition, sound neat, strong feet with well arch toes and good cushioning. Covered plenty of ground on the move smoothly and effortlessly around the ring driving well from behind. A really super girl. Very well-deserved BIS. RBIS Bowen's Flatcoated Retriever D. However, BPIS went to the 11 mo Golden Retriever B Porter's Shearstone Hasta La Vista Very well put together mid gold baby. Excellent angulation, sweet head and expression, very good reach of neck, topline and tail set. Correct coat. Correct amount of bone and good neat feet. Moved effortlessly. I am sure she has a good future ahead. RBPIS Roberts's Byphar Havana Club typical representative of her breed. Great head and expression. Super dense coat all through, good angles and topline with good length of leg. Moved soundly but a little close behind today but I am sure that will sort itself out as she matures.
